

# REAR SEAT PROTECTOR

## Installation Guide

#### **Safety Information**

Before starting, fitting this seat cover will be easier if the vehicle's rear bench seat(s) are able to fold down. With the rear seat(s) slightly folded forward, it will be much easier to securely attach the seat protector's elasticated hem and straps to fit over the seat(s).

Do not attach the hooks to any power seat mechanisms if these are present in the vehicle, wiring or other parts related to operation of the seat: forward, backward, or up and down.

**NOTE:** if possible, please ensure your pet is suitably restrained in the vehicle whilst travelling. Use with a dog harness for ultimate safety. Fits most vehicles with a rear bench seat.

#### **Seat Protector Care**

Wipe the cover clean using a damp cloth or sponge with warm water. Do not put this seat cover in a washing machine or tumble dryer. Do not wring, just drip dry. Do not use with heated rear seat(s).

### **Installing the Rear Seat Protector**

Please ensure you carefully check the size of your rear seat before installing (this cover fits maximum rear bench seat **width 144cm** and maximum rear bench seat **height 123cm**):



Adjust the headrests all the way down. Lower the bench seat by pressing the release latch and pulling the seat slightly forward. Drape the seat cover from the headrests down so it covers as much of the bench seat.



Pull the top edge of the seat cover down over the headrests. Pull the tether strap on one corner so that it attaches to a secure point on the rear of the bench seat. This will ensure that the seat cover won't come off.



Repeat the process from step 2 with the other tether strap so that it's securely attached to a part of the seat's framework towards the rear.



Start repositioning the seat belts from either side so that they are both not hidden and facing towards you. Then move the bench seat back to it's default fixed position ensuring the seat cover hasn't moved.



To finish off, ensure all edges of the seat protector covering the base of the bench seat are pulled as taut as possible for a snug fit.



If desired, you can carefully make small cuts to create slits for the seat belt buckles underneath to be accessible. And if required, you can cut to create slits to allow for the middle occupant's seat belt to be accessible as well. Lastly, you can also make small cuts over the headrest support holes to re-insert detachable headrests so these can be adjusted.
